- i. Call the meeting to Order
  - ✓ Welcome and Introductions

- ii. Approval or Correction of the Minutes
  - ✓ October 18, 2018 DAC meeting

*Motion to accept the minutes with the correction of spelling of Nataly's name corrected by Mrs. Kirchman. Second by Mrs. Gladders. All in favor.*

- iii. Committee Reports
  - ✓ CAASPP Scores Overview - Dashboard (TA)

*Mr. Addington thanked all in attendance explaining the importance of this opportunity to provide input, receive information and serve to share that information out in the community. The State Priorities were reviewed including what they encompassed. Mr. Addington shared changes in the Dashboard view. "It is good to be green." The District's Dashboard for all students is green across all measures. The English Learner Progress indicator is not provided this year due to the transition to ELPAC. Comparison from 2017 to 2018 were displayed. Mr. Addington pointed out that even more significantly was the positive growth of student groups. SchoolZilla is a program that has been purchased to pull data from many sources into one place for administrators to have timely accesses to current actionable data. Stratford's significant attendance improvement was spotlighted. SchoolZilla allows us to dig deeper in our analysis of the data to make adjustments as needed moving forward. DAC attendees were encouraged to visit CA Schools Dashboard.*

iv. Annual Update / Stakeholder Input for LCAP (CR)

*Mrs. Rael provided the attendees with a 1page overview of LCAP including Goals, Metric and Actions/Services. Changes to the 2019-20 LCAP were shared. Annual update was reviewed including data on each metric. Participants provided input to the Annual Update and LCAP.*

v. Questions or Concerns

*Last year we spoke about doing a Districtwide Career Day for 8<sup>th</sup> Graders. Where are we with that? Mrs. Gonzales shared that Akers held one in the evening last Spring. Central and Stratford were invited. Suggestion was to have this type of event during the day so that all students could attend. Parent shared about how Parkview has done this which was definitely mostly focused on careers vs colleges being present. Presentations were provided on a variety of careers. Mrs. Gonzales shared that Aker's event was the same, just during the evening. Nataly suggested a survey for students to complete following the event for feedback for revisions.*

*Danny shared a concern over students being prepared for high school. Knowing A-G, note-taking, binders, ...Mrs. Rael shared that Mr. Raven has been working with LHS to revise the Character Counts Day to make changes to address some of these exact concerns. Mr. Raven shared that he is working with LHS for the day to be more of a "Welcome to LHS" and including resources to assist students in making that transition. He asked to meet with Danny and discuss needs. Needs – Requirements, Connections, visiting the campus, binders, ...Nancy shared that originally, it was not just a quick walk by, rather students sat in a room and had a preview of what certain classes were. Nataly shared that they hear kids ending up in classes that are totally not about what they thought they would be about.*

*Nancy commended Danny and his team on the Parent Engagement classes they are providing to parents. Margaret asked how they were able to get good attendance. Danny shared liaisons speak to parents, flyers were sent home, and Nancy supported with All Calls to families.*
