**Call to Order**

**I. Welcome and Introductions**

Christina Gonzales welcomed everyone and called the meeting to order at 8:34 am. Danny Llamas, Chairperson and Erika Alvarez, Vice Chairperson were not in attendance. Ms. Lozano asked Ms. Gonzales to stand in for Mr. Llamas and Ms. Alvarez.

All Council members present introduced him or herself and stated their role for the DAC council.

**II. Approve minutes from February 22, 2018**

- The February 22, 2018 DAC minutes were read and approved.
- It was motioned, seconded and passed (MSP) by Nancy Davis and Elizabethe Lozano (Davis, Lozano) to accept the February 22, 2018, minutes. (7-0)

**III. History & Social Studies (HSS) Adoption (SC)**

- Mr. Chennault stated this year is an adoption year for History/Social Studies in the District. Mr. Chennault reviewed the adoption process for the council. A vote will take place next week, quote request and order placement to follow. Ms. Lozano stated literature is a big part of this adoption. Ms. Davis asked if the history standards had changed. Ms. Rael answered the standards did not have a significant change, although the subject focus had changed.

**IV. LCAP Update (CR)**

**Engagement and Information**

- Ms. Rael reviewed the LCAP goals and gave an update on where we are. Ms. Rael went over each goal individually, explaining the focus is on the areas of concern and what the District is doing to resolve those concerns. Ms. Rael went over the State Dashboard data, showing the highs (achievements) and lows (needs) of the District. Ms. Rael explained the District strategy to address the needs as concentrating on the concerns without neglecting the other areas so they do not become areas of concern. Ms. Rael asked for input among those present, addressing each goal, what is working well and what is not working. Ms. Rael introduced each goal and the council broke into groups and gave input, examples and suggestions on how to resolve any concerns and achieve the goal put forth.

- Ms. Lozano gave an update on MTSS. Ms. Lozano shared the current focus is on Social-Emotional areas, the next step is Academic areas. The MTSS committee is starting with Reading/Literacy. Ms. Lozano also shared how the District is building the tiers of the MTSS pyramid. Ms. Lozano and Ms. Kirchman explained the Student Connectiveness initiative and what the sites are doing to achieve this goal.

#### **V. Tech Update (MT)**

##### ***Projected Summer Purchases***

- Mr. Tompkins reviewed the projected tech summer purchases. Mr. Tompkins stated the District has been using iPads for approximately 7 years with a 1 to 1 use for the past 3 years. Mr. Tompkins explained the device rotation cycle. This summer the District will be replacing approximately 20% of the current iPad inventory.

- Ms. Kirchman shared the Neutra campus has their Annual Spring Show coming up on May 3rd. Ms. Kirchman also shared their Parent Club is putting on their 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Spring Fling. Neutra's version of the School carnival.
