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**1. Call to Order**

Meeting was called to order at 12:32 by Danny Llamas.

**2. Additions, Deletions, and Approval of Agenda**

Chuck Gent asked to move LCAP and CAASPP for LUHS Academic information to next meeting in February 2021. Christina Gonzales made a motion to accept Mr. Gent's request seconded by Danny Llamas. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously.  
A motion was made by Christina Gonzales to approve agenda with changes seconded by Erika Maldonado. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously.

**3. Approval of the Minutes from the Previous IEC Meeting**

Christina Gonzales made a motion to approve previous IEC minutes seconded by Erika Maldonado. All in favor. Motion passed unanimously.

**4. Introductions of Guests**

Cindee Rael was introduced by Mrs. Lozano as a guest to the IEC meeting.

**6. Student LCAP, CAASPP Academic Data for CUESD & LUHSD**

Ms. Rael presented the following report for Central Union Elementary School District for Central and Stratford Elementary Schools. COVID19 had a significant impact on both State Testing and LCAP as we closed schools in March of 2020 and continue to deal with the pandemic.

### **State Testing Update**

The State did suspend all State Testing and received a waiver from the Federal Government for the suspension.

March 2020 school closure was prior to the opening of our District's CAASPP Assessment window. Therefore, no students were assessed with CAASPP Assessments in Spring 2020. This includes 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students ELA and Math Smarter Balanced Assessments as well as 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Science test, CAST.

The **Summative ELPAC** Assessment window is February – May each year. English Learners in grade 3 at Stratford completed their Summative ELPAC. Some 3<sup>rd</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade students across the district had completed individual domains of the test, but not the entire test. This Fall, the State provided an Optional Summative opportunity for students who had previously met all reclassification criteria except ELPAC. Each site tested a few students with some achieving the required Level 4 Proficiency Level and then reclassified.

For 2020-21, a short version of the ELA and Math SBAC has been approved by the State Board of Education to maximize the number of students able to participate and minimize the time taken from critical instruction.

### **LCAP Update**

In June, rather than taking a new 3-year plan to our Board amidst the pandemic, districts were required to complete a Covid-19 Written Operations Plan. This plan shows how the District responded to the needs of students both educational and meals in the Spring. Next, Districts were required to complete a Learning Continuity & Attendance Plan (LCP) by September 30<sup>th</sup>. Budget Overview for Parents is Due by December 15<sup>th</sup> and is connected to the LCP for this year.

In January, Annual Update templates for 2019-20 and 2020-21 (over the LCP) are to be released. A new 3-year LCAP template will be released this spring. The two annual updates, the 2021-2024 LCAP and the 2021-22 Budget Overview are currently due by June 30<sup>th</sup>. We will continue to engage our stakeholders through a variety of means to ensure greatest opportunity for input.

#### **7. Single Plan for Student Achievement**

Christina Gonzales reported that as a school that receives Title 1 Funding Stratford School focuses on Reading, Language Arts, Math, Attendance, and Student Connectedness. The focus on reading included hiring a teacher working on Tier 3 for students that need additional assistance. These processes and procedures are a continuation of last year.

#### **8. School, Parent, & Student Compact**

Christina Gonzales reported that at Central Union Elementary School District a Student Parent Teacher Compact is signed at the beginning of the school year as part of the back to school process. Michelle King reported that Lemoore Union High School District has a school pledge online for all parents, students, and teachers to agree and complete.

9. **Johnson-O-Malley (JOM) Funding**

John Raven presented the JOM Budget. There were no changes. Balance remains at \$5701.14. Mr. Raven will work with Danny Llamas to spend funds.

10. **Title VI Funding**

Chuck Gent Lemoore High School District Representative stated that currently there are no change. Tutors are working with Santa Rosa Rancheria Ed Department and Danny Llamas.

Chuck Gent also reported on the Title V Budget. Mr. Gent indicated that all invoices have been processed. The plans include working with Danny Llamas to spend additional funding, as well as Anne Gonzales for math intervention for students.

Mr. Llamas said he looked forward to meeting again with ideas on how to spend funding and greatly appreciated the computers that were purchased.

11. **Education Committee Reports (Current Month & One More)**

**Santa Rosa Rancheria (SRR) Danny Llamas** reported that the SRR Education Building is remaining open daily from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. seeing approximately 35 to 50 students daily. Recreation Department is providing snacks and meals. At this time The Education Department cannot transfer students. This will remain in effect until approval from the tribal council and movement from purple tier.

Donza Morales from the Recreation Department is continuing with Community Events and providing meals for students. WASC program is at a standstill due to Purple Tier status however Mrs. Morales said Recreation Department will continue to provide awareness and a safe place for all youth.

**Lemoore Union High School District Michelle King** reported that Jamison High School was in the middle of parent conferences. Mrs. King indicated that dress up days, as well as Mental Health Awareness days were happening currently. The end of the grading period is December 18<sup>th</sup> and Winter Break is December 21, 2020 through January 8, 2021.

Mrs. King continued to report on Lemoore High School that learning labs were in effect with approximately 150 students from 8:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. Lemoore High School will be sending a survey home for parents to choose distance learning or in person hybrid learning. All students are being offered many resources by Nurse/Health Department, Counselors, and Career Center. Many Senior activities are in full effect including FAFSA applications now open. Tutoring is continuing Monday through Thursday as well as Saturday School. Lunches are still being offered to all students.

**Stratford School Christina Gonzales** reported to start she was very grateful to have kids back on campus. Report cards will be mailed home. Mrs. Gonzales indicated that 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students would be returning to campus on January 11, 2021. Drive through distribution of meals was continuing on Wednesdays from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

**Central School Anne Gonzales-** The committee reviewed the written report No Formal presentation was given due to Mrs. Gonzales' absence.
